Pleasure Divisions- No Cross entry

Minimum Assistance Therapeutic Rider- (W/T/J) English and Western compete together. No age restriction. For riders who are unable to participate without assistance. One attendant permitted. Classes for division- 39, 41, 42, 43, 78, 86

Maximum Assistance Therapeutic Rider- (W/T/J) English and Western compete together. No age restriction. For riders who are unable to participate without assistance. Multiple attendants permitted. Classes for division- 39, 41, 42, 43, 78, 86

Note- Minimum & Maximum Assistance Divisions are ridden together but judged separately. If footing is not ideal for walkers the class may be held in the paddock area.

Western Lead Line- Children 10 years of age and under. Multiple attendants are permitted to enter the arena if needed. Classes for division- 40, 44, 45, 46, 50, 77, 85

English Lead Line- Children 10 years of age and under. Multiple attendants are permitted to enter the arena if needed. Classes for division- 40, 47, 48, 49, 50, 77, 85

Western 10 & Under Pleasure- (Walk/Jog) Classes for division- 51 or 52, 53, 58, 59, 60, 79, 87

English 10 & Under Pleasure- (Walk/Trot) Classes for division- 13 or 14, 15, 20, 21, 22, 79, 87

Western Junior Novice Pleasure- Riders age (11-14) who are in their first or second year of showing or the horses first or second year of showing that are not comfortable with gaits above Trot/Jog. (W/T/J) Classes for division- 51 or 52, 54, 61, 62, 63, 80, 88

Western Senior Novice Pleasure- Riders age (15-18) who are in their first or second year of showing or the horses first or second year of showing that are not comfortable with gaits above Trot/Jog. (W/T/J) Classes for division- 51 or 52, 56, 67, 68, 69, 81, 89

English Junior Novice Pleasure- Riders age (11-14) who are in their first or second year of showing or the horses first or second year of showing that are not comfortable with gaits above Trot/Jog. (W/T/J) Classes for division- 13 or 14, 16, 23, 24, 25, 80, 88

English Senior Novice Pleasure- Riders age (15-18) who are in their first or second year of showing or the horses first or second year of showing that are not comfortable with gaits above Trot/Jog. (W/T/J) Classes for division- 13 or 14, 18, 29, 30, 31, 81, 89

English Junior Pleasure- Riders age (11-14) gaits called will be Walk, Trot, or Canter. Classes for division- 13 or 14, 17, 26, 27, 28, 82, 90

Western Junior Pleasure- Riders age (11-14) gaits called will be Walk, Jog, or Lope. Classes for division- 51 or 52, 55, 64, 65, 66, 82, 90

English Senior Pleasure- Riders age (15-18) gaits called will be Walk, Trot, or Canter. Classes for division- 13 or 14, 19, 32, 33, 34, 83, 91

Western Senior Pleasure- Riders age (15-18) gaits called will be Walk, Jog, or Lope. Classes for division- 51 or 52, 57, 70, 71, 72, 83, 91

Open Divisions- May enter any that are appropriate.

Hunter- Open to riders in English tack, Helmets Required. Classes for division- 1, 2, 9, 10, 11, 12

Trot Cross Rails- Open to riders in English tack, Helmets Required. Classes for division- 3, 4, 5

Cross Rails- Open to riders in English tack, Helmets Required. Classes for division- 6, 7, 8

Sport Horse- This division is designed to show the movement and versatility of equine suited to equestrian sporting events, Dressage, Eventing, Show Jumping. Shown in Hunt or Dressage tack and attire. Classes for division- 35, 36, 37, 38

Ranch Horse- Ranch horse classes are designed to show movement and versatility of the working ranch-style horse. Western tack and attire. Classes for division- 73, 74, 75, 76

Miniature Horse- Open to handlers of any age. Classes for division- 106, 107, 108, 84

Gymkhana Divisions- This division is open to any rider. Choose only one division

Gymkhana (Trot)- Open to riders any age who are not yet comfortable with a faster gait. Canter strides will be penalized. Classes for division- 93, 96, 99, 102

Junior Gymkhana- Open to riders aged 11-14 who are comfortable cantering. Classes for division- 94, 97, 100, 103, 105

Senior Gymkhana- Open to riders aged 15-18 who are comfortable cantering. Classes for division- 95, 98, 101, 104, 105

Required Documentation

Current Negative Coggins and proof of Rabies Vaccine- required for the horse to be shown on the grounds. Will be kept on file for future events.

Proof of Membership or Membership application- complete with payment

Horse/Rider combination number registration- same number for the year and used to track year end points and proof of vaccines and coggins.

Horse & Rider Registration form- used to track day end division awards and payment

Individual class slips- are required. A full page of class registration slips provided- to be cut apart at check in

Day End High Point

Day End High Point Division Awards- Competitors may show in:

- **One** Pleasure Division (See choices of Pleasure division in chart above). Note: **No** cross entering into any other pleasure divisions.

- **One** Gymkhana Division (Trot, Junior, or Senior).

- **Any** of the Open divisions (Ranch Horse, Sport Horse, Miniature Horse, Trot Cross Rails, Cross Rails, Hunter).

Points schedule: 1st Place= 6 points, 2nd Place= 5 points, 3rd Place= 4 points, 4th Place= 3 points, 5th Place= 2 points,

6th Place= 1 point. Ties in a division will be determined by the most blue ribbons won, most red ribbons won through the most green ribbons won respectively. The riders or handler with the highest points at the end of the show will be the division champion. Reserve to the next highest in points.
