Divisions: No cross entry between divisions	
Walk-Trot:	Any age rider that is not comfortable at a faster gait then a trot. 2, 3, 4, 8, 14, 19, 25, 32, 37, 42 also 1 & 31
Junior Youth:	Riders aged 14 and younger 5, 6, 7, 9, 15, 20, 26, 33, 38, 43 also 1 & 31
Senior Youth:	Riders aged 15-18 5, 6, 7, 10, 16, 21, 27, 34, 39, 44 also 1&31
Adult:	Riders aged 19 and older 5, 6, 7, 11, 17, 22, 28, 35, 40, 45 also 1 & 31
Draft/Draft Cross:	Any age that has a draft or draft cross. 5, 6, 7, 12, 18, 23, 29, 36, 41, 46 also 1 & 31
Jackpot classes are #13, #24 & #30 and require a separated fee of \$8 each	

General Rules:

1. Fees for this show are:
 - a. **Regular classes \$35 for the night.** Total possible classes entered for this price is 12. Turn in white slips for each class entered.
 - b. Dollar bareback entries bring your own dollar bill.
 - c. Jackpot class 13, 24 & 30 entry fee: \$8 per class. Payback is 50% to top 3 (25% 15% & 10%)
 - d. Grounds fee \$5 (waived for members)
2. Signed waivers must be on file with the show secretary prior to schooling. Youth riders must have a signed waiver by parent or legal guardian in order to school or show. Back numbers must be worn at all times. **All ages as of 1/1/18.**
3. Adding classes must be done a minimum of 2 classes in advance. Add forms must be used.
4. **No refunds for scratched or missed classes!** Excessive abuse of this practice has caused the office staff time and has disrupted the show. Turn in you add slips as needed. Pay as you go or let an open check made out to WRC on file with the show manager. Notify the office immediately in the event of illness or injury to rider or equine. The show manager will document an incident report.
5. Gymkhana Attire: Riders must wear long pants, shirt with sleeve (short sleeves acceptable – no spaghetti strap tops) and riding shoe with heel.
6. Show attire is expected for Pleasure divisions. Judge will not disqualify rider for lack of appointments but may deduct points.
7. Timed Events: Riders must wait until the gate is closed to begin their run.
8. **Cancelation of Classes** – Under circumstances deemed unsafe by the show committee, a class may be postponed to a later date or cancelled.
* In the case of Thunderstorm. The show manager will call a halt to the show in the event of lightening. A 30 minutes hold time is required after lightening is observed. The show committee will deem whether to continue with the show or delay an additional length of time. Delay may be up to a total of a 2 hour hold period. The exhibitors will have the opportunity to be refunded for the classes they could not complete in. If the exhibitor can attend the rain date, the fees and paperwork can be held over. The number fee, office fee and the grounds fee will not be returned.
9. **Conduct Expectations of Competitors** - The WRC Shows are meant to be a fun, family oriented and competitive environment for riders to demonstrate their horsemanship skills. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated by competitors, trainers, parents and/or spectators. This includes but is not limited to the mishandling of an equine and unacceptable language. If unsportsmanlike conduct is observed, the violator will be asked to leave the grounds and forfeit any and all entry fees. Trainers, parents and spectators displaying such behavior will be asked to vacate the premises.
10. No Smoking near the rings, in or around any of the buildings on the riding club grounds.
11. Do not let children unattended on the bleachers, in the club house or the bathroom. Anyone making a disturbance will be asked to leave the ringside.
12. The property is monitored by surveillance cameras.
13. The PA system is a convenience. Note: If classes are being judged as an open card class (ex: Showmanship, Halter, In-hand Trail, Trail, Ground poles, Gymkhana, over fences & classes gaming) and no one is waiting in line an order of go will be given. If 2 minutes expires the class will be pinned.
14. East Ring will begin at 6 pm and will run on an open card for poles and cutback classes in order to help facilitate the show.
