

WRC 2019 Year-End Awards Year-end banquet held on November 2, 2019.

Points are earned by a horse / rider combination. **Each horse / rider combo is required to have a unique number.** This number is used for the season to track points. These points are not transferable if horse or rider are injured/ unsound or otherwise unable to compete.

Year-end Show Series Awards: Points are automatically tracked. The Williamsport Riding Club offers 6 show series in order to earn year-end division points: The Children's Show, Schooling Dressage, Friday Night Gaming, Hunter, Sunday Open Series with SVC and Saturday Open Show Series. Riders may select one **Pleasure**, one **Gymkhana** and any **Open** divisions in which to compete. See series show flyer for division details. The overall highest points earned within each division is awarded Grand Champion followed by Reserve. Riders must indicate their choice of division(s) at the beginning of the show in order to collect points. All series shows count equally for points. Club membership is not required to collect points for series day end or year end series awards. (Membership **is** required to earn points for Member Division and Member Over-all Top 10 Awards.)

Year-end Member Division Awards: The Williamsport Riding Club offers **three** categories to earn year-end member division points (**Pleasure, Gymkhana and Open**). All disciplines compete for the overall highest points earned within each division. Members may select one division in the Pleasure, one division in the Gymkhana and any divisions that apply in Open. Members must indicate their choice of division(s) at the first event in which to collect points.

Member Overall Year-end Top 10 Awards- Points on an individual horse rider combination are tallied for all show series points + an additional point for each class entered.

Pleasure divisions – No cross entry within Pleasure divisions.

1. Lead line – Rider 10 years and under as of January 1st, 2019. (Walk-Trot/Jog) Attendants permitted to enter the arena with the competitor.
(English and Western Lead line classes earn points in this division)
2. Novice Jr. Youth Pleasure (11-14) – (Walk – Trot/Jog) for riders that are not comfortable with gates above Trot/Jog.
(English Novice (11-14), Western Novice (11-14) classes earn points in this division)
3. Novice Sr. Youth Pleasure (15-18) – (Walk – Trot/Jog) for riders that are not comfortable with gates above Trot/Jog.
(English Novice (15-18), Western Novice (15-18) classes earn points in this division)
4. Novice Adult Pleasure (19 & up) – (Walk – Trot/Jog) for riders that are not comfortable with gates above Trot/Jog. (Western/English Adult Novice classes earn points in this division)
5. Masters Pleasure (Walk – Trot/Jog) Riders 30 years of age and over as of January 1st, 2019.
This division is for those not comfortable riding faster than a trot/jog. (Masters Pleasure classes earn points in this division)
6. 10 & Under Pleasure – (Walk – Trot/Jog) Riders age 10 and under as of January 1st, 2019.
(English 10 & Under, Western 10 & under classes earn points in this division)
7. Junior Youth Pleasure – Riders age 14 and under as of January 1st, 2019.
(English Junior Youth, Western Junior Youth classes earn points in this division)
8. Senior Youth Pleasure – Riders 15 – 18 years of age as of January 1st, 2019.
(English Senior Youth, Western Senior Youth classes earn points in this division)
9. Adult Pleasure – Riders over 18 years of age as of January 1st, 2019.
(Adult Pleasure classes earn points in this division)

Gymkhana divisions – No cross entry within Gymkhana divisions

10. Trot Gymkhana – This division is for those not comfortable riding faster than a trot.
11. Jr. Youth Gymkhana – Open to riders age 14 and under.
12. Sr. Youth Gymkhana – Open to riders age 15 to 18.
13. Adult Gymkhana – Open to riders over 18

Open divisions – Cross entry is permitted in the additional divisions listed below.

14. Trot Cross rails – Open to rider in the trot division. English tack and helmets required.
15. Cross rails – Open to rider in English tack Helmets required. **May not show in Trot Cross rail classes.**
16. Youth Hunter – Open to riders. Protective head gear is required for fence classes and schooling.
17. Adult Hunter – Open to riders over are 18. Protective head gear is required for fence classes and schooling.
18. Miniature Horse – Open to exhibitors of all ages showing a miniature horse.
19. Dressage Junior – Open to exhibitors 14 and under showing Dressage. (Jr. Dressage classes earn points in this division)
20. Dressage Senior – Open to exhibitors 15 and over showing Dressage. (Sr. Dressage classes earn points in this division)
21. Ranch Horse – Open to exhibitors showing in Western tack. Ranch Horse classes earn points in this division.
22. Sport Horse – This division is designed to show the movement and versatility of equine suited to equestrian sporting events dressage, eventing, show jumping shown in Hunt or Dressage tack and attire.
23. Therapeutic Max (Walk-Trot/Jog) Open to riders of any age who are unable to participate in other divisions without accommodations. Attendants are permitted to enter the arena with the competitor if needed. *If footing is too soft the paddock areas may be used for the showmanship class to accommodate wheelchairs.*
24. Therapeutic Min (Walk-Trot/Jog) Open to riders of any age who are unable to participate in other divisions without accommodations. Attendants are permitted to enter the arena with the competitor if needed. May show in therapeutic advanced division
25. Therapeutic Advanced (Walk-Trot/Jog/Canter/Lope) Open to riders of any age who participate in other therapeutic divisions.

Hearing impaired riders please notify Show manager for instructions on giving cues for change of gaits.

26. Open Driving– Horse, Pony, Miniature horse and Draft will compete together. Will split if class is too large whip gloves and lap robe/apron required

Note: An Individual or Family Membership application must be completed and received at or before the show at which the member wishes to earn points. Members in good standing with the club will be eligible for any year-end awards (i.e. Volunteer hours, etc...) August 1st deadline for tracking member points for these awards.
