

HIGH POINT DIVISIONS- Ages as of January 1st 2019 Please enter in the age appropriate divisions. Divisions are to keep the rider and the horse safe and comfortable at their skill levels and to promote sportsmanship, and provide equal ability competition. While giving the rider time to master a division before moving up. Open divisions are used to try a different skill with out interfering with the day end and year end points schedule. Series Daily High Point- Points are awarded in Pleasure, Open & Gymkhana divisions. Competitors may show in: •**One Pleasure** •**One Gymkhana Division (Trot, Jr , or Sr.)** • **Any of the Open Divisions.** 1st Place= 6 points, 2nd = 5, 3rd = 4, 4th = 3, 5th = 2, 6th = 1. The highest points at the end of the show will be the division champion. Reserve to the next highest in points. Ties in a division will be determined by the most blue ribbons won, most red ribbons won through the most green ribbons won respectively.

Pleasure Divisions- No Cross entry (Advanced Therapeutic riders welcome)

Western Lead Line- Children - 10 years of age and under. Multiple attendants are permitted

English lead Line - Children - 10 years of age and under. Multiple attendants are permitted

Western 10 & Under Pleasure - (Walk/Jog)

English 10 & Under Pleasure - (Walk/Trot)

Western Jr. Novice Pleasure - Riders age (11-14) in their 1st or 2nd year of showing or the horses first or second year of showing that are not comfortable with gaits above Trot/Jog. (W/T/J)

English Jr. Novice Pleasure - Rides age (11-14) in their 1st or 2nd year of showing or the horses first or second year of showing that are not comfortable with gaits above Trot/Jog. (W/T/J)

Western Sr. Novice Pleasure - Riders age (15-18) in their 1st or 2nd year of showing or the horses first or second year of showing that are not comfortable with gaits above Trot/Jog. (W/T/J)

English Sr. Novice Pleasure - Riders age (15-18) in their 1st or 2nd year of showing or the horses first or second year of showing that are not comfortable with gaits above Trot/Jog. (W/T/J)

Western Junior Pleasure - Riders age (11-14) gaits called will be Walk, Jog, or Lope.

English Junior Pleasure - Riders age (11-14) gaits called will be Walk, Trot, or Canter.

Western Senior Pleasure - Riders age (15-18) gaits called will be Walk, Jog, or Lope.

English Senior Pleasure - Riders age (15-18) gaits called will be Walk, Trot, or Canter.

Open Divisions- May enter any that are appropriate.

Therapeutic Rider Maximum Assistance - (W/T/J) English and Western compete together. For riders who are unable to participate without assistance. Multiple attendants permitted.

Therapeutic Rider Minimum Assistance - (W/T/J) English and Western compete together. For riders who are unable to participate some assistance. One attendant permitted.

Therapeutic Rider Advanced - (W/T/J/L/C) English and Western compete together. May cross enter with max.

Therapeutic Riders Note- No age restriction for therapeutic riders. If footing is not ideal for walkers the class may be held in the paddock area. Hearing impaired riders please notify show manager for instructions on giving cues for change of gaits.

Hunter- Open, Trot Cross Rails-, Cross Rails- Open to riders in English tack, helmets required.

Sport Horse- This division is designed to show the movement and versatility of equine suited to equestrian sporting events, Dressage, Eventing, Show Jumping. Shown in Hunt or Dressage tack and attire.

Ranch Horse- Ranch horse classes are designed to show movement and versatility of the working ranch-style horse. Western tack and attire.

Miniature Horse- Open to handlers of any age. (Therapeutic are welcome within this division)

Open Driving- Horse, Pony, Miniature horse and Draft will compete together. Will split if class is too large.

Whip, gloves & apron or lap robe required.

Gymkhana Divisions- This division is open to any rider. Choose only one division

Gymkhana (Trot) - Open to riders any age who are not yet comfortable with a faster gait. Canter strides will be penalized. Exhibition class is provided for advanced riders to warm-up.

Junior Youth Gymkhana - Open to riders aged 11-14 who are comfortable cantering.

Senior Youth Gymkhana - Open to riders aged 15-18 who are comfortable cantering.

Required Documentation

1. Current Negative Coggins 2. proof of Rabies Vaccine- required for the horse to be on the grounds, 3. Proof of Membership or Membership application- complete with payment 4. Horse/Rider combination number registration- same number for the year 5. Horse & Rider Registration form- used to track day end division awards and payment 6. Individual class slips- are required. A full page of class registration slips provided- to be cut apart at check in. **Rules and Other Information posted on the website: www.williamsportridingclub.com**

1. For all classes, the entry fee is \$8.00 unless otherwise stated. Ex. Exhibition \$5 each run.

2. Other fees: Office fee \$5 waived for pre entry if received 10 days prior to show.

3. Grounds fee are \$5 each per horse rider combination. Waived for WRC members.

4. Make check to payable WRC. Any returned check will be charged \$40.00

5. WRC, managers or volunteers and or property owners will not be responsible for any accidents, loss or damages which may occur to any horse, rider, spectator, groom or equipment before, during or after the horse show.
