Main Ring 7:00 3D Barrel competition

Pee Wee -10 & Under Ribbons 1-6 and Prize to the high point in division

Youth - 17 & under

Adult -18 & over

Open – any age

Cash payback to top 3 in each division: Youth, Adult and Open
50% of division registration is paid back to placing's 1-3 (25%-15%-10%)

Definition of Divisions for Day End and Year End Awards:

Riders must choose a division at registration for day end high-point and year-end awards. To qualify for day-end high-point championship awards for this series, riders will collect points in the indicated classes below. 1st = 6 points 2nd = 5 points 3rd = 4 points 4th = 3 points 5th = 2 points 6th = 1 point. All riders are welcome to ride in Jackpot classes, (**6, 12, 18, 29**) but they will not count toward day end division awards - only year-end high point member awards for Gymkhana open. See website for member qualifications.

Gymkhana Youth Trot—open to riders of age 18 and under (W/T only)

Classes: **1, 7, 13, 19, 24, 30, 35**

Gymkhana Adult Trot— open to riders 19 years of age and over as of 1/1/19. (W/T only)

Classes: **2, 8, 14, 20, 25, 31, 36**

Junior Youth Gymkhana —open to riders 14 years of age and under as of 1/1/19

Classes: **3, 9, 15, 21, 26, 32, 37**

Senior Youth Gymkhana —open to riders 15 years to 18 years age as of 1/1/19

Classes: **4, 10, 16, 22, 27, 33, 38**

Adult Gymkhana —open to riders 19 years of age and over as of 1/1/19

Classes: **5, 11, 17, 23, 28, 34, 39**

General Information:

Exhibition fee: \$5 at the gate

Regular Entry Fees: \$8/class. Make checks payable to WRC. Any returned check shall be charged a \$30 fee.

Family members may be grouped and paid with one check. Trainer or farm checks will not be accepted for students.

Jackpot Class Entry fee: \$10 (classes 6, 12, 18, 29) Cash prizes - 50% of registration is paid back to placing's 1-3 (25%-15%-10%)

Ribbons: Flat ribbons through 6th place

Number fee: \$2 A onetime number fee for each horse rider combination will be charged. Points will be tracked with this number. This number will be used for all WRC shows held on the grounds. This fee is not refundable. Rider is responsible for having the number on.

Office Fee: \$5 per horse/rider combination, waived with pre entry 10 days prior to show.

Grounds Fee: \$5 (2019 WRC members are exempt)

NEW Pay one price for the gaming division: \$40 Regular class fee per division (does not include Office Fee, exhibitions, 3D or jackpot)

3D Barrel fees: Pee Wee -\$5, Youth \$15, Adult \$15, Open \$30

General Rules: No refunds for scratched classes

1. Signed waivers must be on file with the show secretary prior to schooling. Youth riders must have a signed waiver by parent or legal guardian in order to school or show.
2. Back numbers must be worn at all times and must be easily visible. If on saddle, it must show from both sides.
3. Adding classes must be done a minimum of 2 classes in advance. Use the Add forms provided in the office. No refunds for scratched classes unless illness or injury to rider or equine. Dr. or Vet verification is required for pre-entry refund.
4. Timed event: Riders must wait until the gate is closed to begin their run.
5. Gymkhana Attire: Riders must wear long pants, short sleeves acceptable – no spaghetti strap tops and riding shoe with heel.

Check in: Form two lines on for pre entry & one for day of registration.

Required documentation:

Current Negative Coggins and proof of Rabies vaccine - required to be on the show grounds

Proof of membership or Membership application - complete with payment

Back number registration form – a new # for each horse rider combination used for the year and used to track yearend points

Horse / rider registration form - Used to track day end division awards and payment.

Individual class - registration slips are required. A full page of class registration slips is provided. To be cut apart at check in. This will save time at check in and provide a better opportunity for the show to start on time. Forms can be found on line.

Cancelation Of Classes – Under circumstances deemed unsafe by the show committee, a class may be postponed to a later date or cancelled. Refunds will be offered for classes entered (note the office fee and grounds fee are not refunded)

Points schedule: 1st Place= 6 points 2nd place = 5 points 3rd place = 4 points 4th place = 3 points 5th Place = 2 points 6th place = 1 point. Ties in a division will be determined by the most blue ribbons won, most red ribbons won through most green ribbons won respectively.

Series Year End High Point Division Awards - The riders, drivers or handler with the highest points from all three shows will be the series division champion. The selection of division from the first show determines the year end division for the year-end series award.

WRC Year End Member Division Awards—WRC club members are eligible for one pleasure, one gymkhana and any of the appropriate open division awards. The points collected in classes entered in the selected division plus a point for every class entered is included for the divisional awards. Opportunity class points are applied to these awards. Membership form and payment must be turned in before collecting points for the day. Also see membership requirements.

WRC Member Overall Top Ten Year End Awards – WRC club members have an opportunity to collect points for high point overall awards. Every point earned in every class entered in each of the WRC shows plus a point for every class enters on a single horse rider combination.

Membership: Forms can be found on the website and at the show office. Member points are kept on horse rider combination for each show. Points for Member awards count when the membership is submitted. Any points earned prior to submission will not count toward Member high point awards, so be sure to sign up before you show. All awards are given at the yearend banquet November 2nd, 2019

Membership deadline: to have points tracked for member year end is July 1st.

Conduct Expectations of Competitors - The WRC Gaming Show Series is meant to be a fun, family oriented and competitive environment for riders of all ages to demonstrate their horsemanship skills. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated by competitors, trainers, parents and/or spectators. This includes but is not limited to the mishandling of an equine and unacceptable language. If unsportsmanlike conduct is observed, the competitor may be asked to leave the grounds and forfeit any and all entry fees. Trainers, parents and spectators displaying such behavior will be asked to vacate the premises.

Trainer Tracking-Trainer points are collected on the students' performance. Trainer must be a member of the club to be eligible. Trainers need to document and submit their students that competed at each event on the provided trainer tracking sheet. If the trainer is not present at the event the point are not valid for the day.
