

HIGH POINT DIVISIONS- Ages as of January 1st 2019

This joint venture to help grow attention to each organization SVC and the WRC and Open Combined Series three Day end High Point awards will be awarded. Junior, Senior & Miniature Horse (mini division is only run at WRC)

1st Place= 6 points, 2nd = 5, 3rd = 4, 4th = 3, 5th = 2, 6th = 1. The highest points at the end of the show will be the division champion. Reserve to the next highest in points. Ties in a division will be determined by the most blue ribbons won, most red ribbons won through the most green ribbons won respectively.

- Youth high point division: age 18 and under
- Adult high point division: over age 18
- Miniature Horse – Open to exhibitors of all ages showing a miniature horse.
- **Therapeutic Riders Note - No age restriction for therapeutic riders. If footing is not ideal for walkers the class may be held in the paddock area. Hearing impaired riders please notify show manager for instructions on giving cues for change of gates.**

Required Documentation

1. Rabies & current negative Coggins test is required to be on the grounds.
2. Proof of Rabies Vaccine- required for the horse to be on the grounds.
3. Proof of Membership or Membership application- complete with payment.
4. Horse/Rider combination number registration- same number for the year
5. Horse & Rider Registration form- used to track day end division awards and payment
6. Individual class slips- are required. A full page of class registration slips provided - to be cut apart at check in.
7. For all classes, the entry fee is \$8.00 unless otherwise stated.
8. Exhibition \$5 each run.
Other fees: Office fee \$5 (waived for pre entry if received 10 days prior to show.)
9. Grounds fee is \$5 each per horse rider combination. Waived for WRC members.
10. Make check payable to WRC. Any returned check will be charged \$40.00.
11. WRC, managers or volunteers and or property owners will not be responsible for any accidents, loss or damages which may occur to any horse, rider, spectator, groom or equipment before, during or after the horse show. A signed waiver must be signed while riding on the grounds. Back number need to be worn and visible while on the grounds.

13. Rider under the age of 18 are recommended to wear SEI approved helmets.
14. Proper show attire and equipment is required.
15. Divisions for high point are Junior (Youth), Senior (Adult) and Miniature Horse (WRC only)
