RULES and High Point Divisions: Each horse rider combination can accumulate points in one or more divisions. See descriptions below. Riders can earn points in one Pleasure division, Hunter over Fences division, Hunter on the Flat division as well as the Open division. The office must be notified before the start of the show of your division choices. *Please show sportsmanship when entering the divisions please don't ride down in ability just to monopolize points for a day end award.*

Points System: 1st place 6 points, 2nd place 5 points, 3rd place 4 points, 4th place 3 points, 5th place 2 points, 6th place 1 point. Six ribbons per class.

Open Divisions – (*chose one of the divisions below for a fee of \$30 per division*)

Trot Cross Rails Division – Riders any age may show in classes 1, 2, 3, 4 (and may also try class 5 at no extra charge.) *Riders in this division may show in other divisions.*

Hunter Over Fences Division: Riders in this division are of any age. Classes 5, 6, 7, 8, 9. *Riders in this division may show in other divisions.*

Hunter on the Flat Division: Riders in this division are of any age. Classes 10, 11, 12, 13. *Riders in this division may show in other divisions.*

Arabian Division: Riders any age may show in classes 17, 32, 33, and 34. *Riders in this division may show in other divisions.*

Sport Horse Division: Riders any age may show in classes 26, 43, 44, and 45. *Riders in this division may show in other divisions.*

Miniature Horse Division: Riders any age can show in classes 18, (23, 24 or 25), 58, 63, 64, 65 and 66.

Therapeutic Riders Division: Age is not a limiting factor for the therapeutic rider Minimum & Maximum assistance will compete together in this division. Classes 30, 31, 56, 61, 69. *No halter class for this division.*

Ranch Horse Division: Riders in this division are of any age. For points in this division, riders can show in the classes 71, 72, 73, 74. *Riders in this division may show in other divisions.*

Pleasure Division – (*chose one of the divisions below for a fee of \$50*)

Lead Line Division: Riders age 9 & under can show in classes and classes 23, 27, 28, 29, 57, 62, 70. *No halter class for this division.*

Pee Wee Division: Riders 12 and under can show in the appropriate halter class and (one halter 17-22), 23, 39, 40, 41, 54, 59, 67. Pee Wee classes are WALK/TROT. *Riders in this division may show in other divisions.*

Youth Hunter Division: Riders in this division are 18 years and under. Riders can show in the appropriate halter classes and classes. 10, 14, 15, 16, (One halter class 17-22), 23 or 24 showmanship, 54, 59 and 67.

Youth Western Division: Riders in this division are 18 years and under. Riders can show in the show the appropriate halter class and classes (17-22) 23 or 24 showmanship, 48, 49, 50, 54, 59 and 67.

Adult Division: Riders in this division are over 18 years old. Riders can show in the appropriate halter class (17-22) and 25, 51, 52, 53, 55, 60, 68.

Master/ Rusty Riders Division: Riders age 35 and over that don't regularly show. Riders of any seat are welcome in this division. Riders can show in the appropriate halter class (17-22) and 25, 36, 37, 38, 55, 60, 68

GENERAL RULES

1. Fees: Open division - \$30 per division shown, Pleasure Divisions Fee \$50 for the division. Jackpot classes are \$10 per class. (50% Pay back to the top 3 places) Use green registration class slips for jackpot class registration. Classes entered outside of a divisions is \$10 per class. Check made payable to NC-PAHA Any returned check will be charged an additional \$30 fee. Office/grounds fee of \$5.00 is included in the division fee. If only registering for individual classes a \$5 ground/office fee will be charged. Stall fee: Horse Stall \$10 Tack Stall \$10.00
2. **Health requirement:** All animals exhibited at the show must be in good health and condition. Any animal showing signs of illness, lameness or poor condition will be asked to leave the grounds by the show committee. All equine on the grounds must have a current negative Coggins. Please present at the show office. ***Negative Coggins required please show at Office upon arrival.***
3. Please make entries at least two (2) classes prior to the class you wish to enter. Please use the Scratch / Add form. Those that ride thru the gate without registering for the class may be charged double the individual entry fee.
4. Please notify the secretary's stand of any needed tack changes; tack changes will be limited to 3 minutes and must be for back to back classes. In order to keep the show moving, the show committee will award only two tack changes to a competitor. Tack changes need to take place at the gate. Please plan accordingly.
5. The show will run with a 2 minute gate. This means the gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring.
6. **STALLS:** We have a limited number, we are not permitted to use all the stalls on the grounds. Please do not use a stall without checking with the show office regarding availability and price. **All bedding and debris must be removed from the stalls upon the completion of the show.**
7. Judge's decision shall be final! If you wish to speak to the judge see the show manager.
8. Safe riding attire is expected – i.e. boots/shoes with heels – and protective head gear **MUST** be worn over jumps at all times.
9. Camping- A limited number of electrical hook ups are available. Please contact Amy for reservation. \$25 camping fee. 570-660-5085
10. Neither the PA Arabian Horse Assn NC District nor the Lycoming County Fair Association shall be responsible for any injuries to horses or exhibitors or for any lost or stolen equipment.
