Points System:

1st place 6 points, 2nd place 5 points, 3rd place 4 points, 4th place 3 points, 5th place 2 points, 6th place 1 point. Ribbons are awarded through 6th place. WRC members receive an additional point for entering each class. This includes the exhibition classes. These points count for the Year-end Overall Member Award total.

GENERAL RULES

1. Class Entry Fees: \$8.00
2. Check made payable to WRC Any returned check will be charged an additional \$30 fee.
3. Office/Grounds Fee* is \$5.00*Office/Grounds fee assessed to keep individual class costs from increasing.
4. Health requirement: All animals exhibited at the show must be in good health and condition. Any animal showing signs of illness, lameness or poor condition will be asked to leave the grounds by the show committee. All equine on the grounds must have a current negative Coggins. Please present at the show office. ***Negative Coggins required please show at Office upon arrival.***
5. Please make entries at least two (2) classes prior to the class you wish to enter. Please use the Scratch / Add form.
6. Please notify the secretary's stand of any needed tack changes; tack changes will be limited to 3 minutes and must be for back to back classes. In order to keep the show moving, the show committee will award only two tack changes to a competitor. Tack changes need to take place at the gate. Please plan accordingly.
7. The show will run with a 2 minute gate. This means the gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring. This WILL BE enforced.
8. Judge's decision shall be final! If you wish to speak with the judge contact the show office.
9. Safe riding attire is expected – i.e. boots/shoes with heels – and protective head gear MUST be worn over jumps at all times.
10. Camping- A limited number of electrical hook ups are available. Please contact Amy for reservation. \$25 camping fee.
11. The Williamsport Riding Club shall not be responsible for any injuries to horses or exhibitors or for any lost or stolen equipment.
12. **Division Championships** will be presented in the ring after each division.
