GENERAL RULES

1. Class Entry Fees: \$8.00
2. Check made payable to NC-PAHA Any returned check will be charged an additional \$30 fee.
3. Office/Grounds Fee* is \$5.00*Office/Grounds fee assessed to keep individual class costs from increasing.
4. Stall fee: Horse Stall \$10 Tack Stall \$5.00
5. Health requirement: All animals exhibited at the show must be in good health and condition. Any animal showing signs of illness, lameness or poor condition will be asked to leave the grounds by the show committee. All equine on the grounds must have a current negative Coggins. Please present at the show office. ***Negative Coggins required please show at Office upon arrival.***
6. Please make entries at least two (2) classes prior to the class you wish to enter. Please use the Scratch / Add form.
7. Please notify the secretary's stand of any needed tack changes; tack changes will be limited to 3 minutes and must be for back to back classes. In order to keep the show moving, the show committee will award only two tack changes to a competitor. Tack changes need to take place at the gate. Please plan accordingly.
8. The show will run with a 2 minute gate. This means the gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring. This WILL BE enforced.
9. STALLS: We have a limited number, most of which are used by our youth who attend the Saturday clinic. We are not permitted to use all the stalls on the grounds. Please do not use a stall without checking with the show office regarding availability and price. **All bedding and debris must be removed from the stalls upon the completion of the show.**
10. Judge's decision shall be final! If you wish to speak with the judge contact the show office.
11. Safe riding attire is expected – i.e. boots/shoes with heels – and protective head gear MUST be worn over jumps at all times.
12. Camping- A limited number of electrical hook ups are available. Please contact Amy for reservation. \$25 camping fee.
13. Neither the PA Arabian Horse Assn NC District nor the Lycoming County Fair Association shall be responsible for any injuries to horses or exhibitors or for any lost or stolen equipment.
14. **Division Championships** will be presented in the ring after each division. This show is part of the WRC Open Show Series. Year end awards Banquet will be November 7th at the Community Baptist church Montoursville. See web site: www.williamsportridingclub.com for details.
