- 3) Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation (8 & Under) - no jumping, Walk, Walk/Trot, and Walk/Trot/Canter
- 4) Short Stirrup Equitation (10 & Under) - X's, W/T, W/T/C, O/F
- 5) Beginner Rider (1st or 2nd year of showing X's) - children only, W/T, W/T/C, O/F
- 6) Long Stirrup (Adult Only X's) - W/T, W/T/C, O/F
- 7) Short Stirrup Hunter (10 & Under) - 1'9", O/F, O/F, U/S
- 8) Pleasure Pony (Children only) - 2', W/T, W/T/C, O/F
- 9) Low Children's Pony - 2' for all - O/F, O/F, U/S
- 10) Novice Equitation (< 3 blue ribbons prior to 1/1/21, Adults & Children) - 2', W/T, W/T/C, O/F
- 11) 2' Modified Hunter (Often called Low Hunter, Amateurs and Children only) - O/F, O/F, U/S
- 12) Baby Green Hunter Pony (Children only) - 2', O/F, O/F, U/S

Class #3- II.2.a - If clean in the first round, exhibitor will exit ring and those who have completed the first portion cleanly will return for a timed 2nd round after all first rounds have completed.

WRC Day End & Series Divisions will include: Appropriate Halter, Appropriate Showmanship, Appropriate In-Hand Ground Poles & Appropriate Mounted Ground Poles. These will be awarded at the Year End Banquet.

Note: Colonial Classic requires WRC membership to qualify. Separate Payment is required.

WRC Membership Fee: \$20 Individual, \$30 Family, 18 year olds must have Individual membership – may join day of show – subject to final approval at following WRC meeting. Members must be in good standing to be recommended to the Colonial Classic and to receive any division awards.

1. Fees: All divisions WRC & CCQ, entry fee is \$35.00. The Medal Stake and Galen Memorial Stake Challenge classes are \$15. Grounds Fee \$5. Office Fee \$10. Late fee is \$25 after 5 p.m. Wednesday.
2. All riders must have a signed waiver prior to schooling or showing in addition to wearing their WRC assigned back number. All riders must wear properly fitting ASTM and SEI headgear with harness secured when riding anywhere on the show grounds.
3. Proof of Negative coggins test and rabies certificate must be provided with entry.
4. The horse show management reserves the right to limit classes or entries in any class or division. The horse show management also reserves the right to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, as the competition warrants. More rules on club website. Judges decisions are final.
5. Champion will be awarded to the rider scoring the highest number of points within the division. Must have three in the division to award a champion. Point for placing: 1st- 6 pts, 2nd- 5 pts, 3rd- 4 pts, 4th- 3 pts, 5th- 2 pts, 6th- 1 point. Ties are broken by the highest placing over fence class. Or by the highest number of blues in division and downward till tie is broken. If tie still stands show committee will toss coin.
6. Day end awards for each WRC division will be awarded at the Banquet with the series end awards
7. You must indicate at the start of show if you intend to compete at the Colonial Classic Show
8. USEF rules apply. USEF age is as of December 1st. WRC rule govern were applicable.
9. WRC, managers or volunteers and or property owners will not be responsible for any accidents, loss or damages which may occur to any horse, rider, spectator, groom or equipment before, during or after the horse show.
10. All classes except Showmanship, In-Hand Ground Poles, Mounted Ground Poles and Galen Memorial Pleasure Stake classes qualify for the Colonial Classic Show.
11. Returned checks will be charged according to ReSubmit program.
12. Dogs must be leashed at all times.
13. Sportsmanship is expected at all times. Show staff are volunteers. Please appreciate their work.
