Deadline Wednesday before show 5 p.m. Late fee will be charged for late registration of \$25. Registration form available on the WRC website [www.williamsportridingclub.com](http://www.williamsportridingclub.com)
2. Registration must be signed. Parent or legal guardian signature needed for youth under 18.
3. Class may be added day of show. Please make entries at least two (2) classes prior to the class entered. Please use the Scratch / Add form.
4. Individual Class slips are required for each class entered.
5. Class Entry Fees: \$8.00
6. Check made payable to NC-PAHA Any returned check will be charged an additional \$30 fee.
7. Office/Grounds Fee\* is \$5.00\*Office/Grounds fee assessed to keep individual class costs from increasing.
8. This is a WRC Pointed show hosted by the NC-PAHA. WRC Members collect points for year end member divisions and Top ten overall Member awards.
9. Health requirement: All animals exhibited at the show must be in good health and condition. Any animal showing signs of illness, lameness or poor condition will be asked to leave the grounds by the show committee. All equine on the grounds must have a current negative Coggins. Please submit with entries. If coggins will run out between the time of pre-registration and the show date please show at office upon arrival on the grounds.
10. Please notify the secretary's stand of any needed tack changes; tack changes will be limited to 3 minutes and must be for back to back classes. In order to keep the show moving, the show committee will award only two tack changes to a competitor. Tack changes need to take place at the gate. Please plan accordingly.
11. The show will run with a 2 minute gate. This means the gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring.
12. Judge's decision shall be final! If you wish to speak with the judge contact the show office.
13. Safe riding attire is expected – i.e. boots/shoes with heels – and protective head gear MUST be worn over jumps at all times.
14. WRC Camping- A limited number of electrical hook ups are available. Please contact Amy for reservation. \$25 camping fee.
15. Neither the PA Arabian Horse Assn NC District nor the Lycoming County Fair Association shall be responsible for any injuries to horses or exhibitors or for any lost or stolen equipment.
16. **Division Championships** will be presented in the ring after each division. Points from this show is part of the WRC Open Show Series.
