### **Rules and information:**

1. Fees: All divisions entry fee is \$35.00. Grounds fee \$5. Office Fee \$10. Late fee is \$25 after 5 p.m. Wednesday. Halter class fees are included in the WRC trail divisions. Adding classes' day of show is permitted.  
Opportunity Fun classes Fee: classes \$5 each, placed 1-6, no points are tracked, signed waiver required, Adult/Youth Challenge - Each rider pays \$5  
Pre entry is required. Individual Class slips are required. A fillable form is provided. See website for detailed instructions. Riders and members must be in good standing to be receive series and year end awards.
2. All riders must have a signed waiver prior to schooling or showing. WRC back assigned number must be visible.
3. Proof of Negative coggins test and rabies certificate must be provided with entry.
4. The horse show management reserves the right to limit classes or entries in any class or division. The horse show management reserves the right to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, as the competition warrants. More rules on club website. Judges decisions are final.
5. Champion to be awarded to the rider scoring the highest number of points within the division. Must have three in the division to award a champion. Point for placing: 1<sup>st</sup>-6 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup>-5 pts, 3<sup>rd</sup>-4 pts, 4<sup>th</sup>- 3 pts, 5<sup>th</sup>- 2 pts, 6<sup>th</sup>- 1 point. Or by the highest number of blues in division and downward till tie is broken. Ties are broken by the highest placing equitation class. If tie still stands show committee will toss coin.
6. WRC is practicing Social distancing. Pre-entry is required to minimize points of contact. Adding a class is permitted the day of the show.
7. You must indicate at the start of show if you intend to compete in a division.
8. USEF rules apply. USEF age is as of December 1<sup>st</sup>. WRC rules govern were applicable.
9. WRC, managers or volunteers and or property owners will not be responsible for any accidents, loss or damages which may occur to any horse, rider, spectator, groom or equipment before, during or after the horse show.
10. All riders must wear properly fitting ASTM and SEI head gear with harness secured with harness secured while riding anywhere on the grounds.
11. Returned checks will be charged according to ReSubmit program.
12. Dogs must be leashed at all times.
13. WRC Trail Area Divisions awards will distributed at the banquet.
14. Member awards are also given at banquet. Note: Separate Payment is required for Club membership (WRC Membership Fee: \$20 Individual, \$30 Family – memberships may be submitted the morning of show to collect points – subject to final approval at next WRC meeting.) members must be in good standing to receive any division awards.
15. Open Beginner horse/pony and beginner rider divisions are day end divisions (not Year End Divisions).
16. Sportsmanship is expected at all times. Show staff are volunteers please appreciate their work.
17. WRC membership is not required to participate in the show series. This series does offer year end awards presented at the Banquet.
