Rules and information:

1. Fees: All divisions entry fee is \$35.00. Grounds fee \$5 Office Fee \$10 Late fee is \$25 after 5pm Wednesday. Individual Class slips are required also. A fillable form is provided. See website for detailed instructions. Riders and members must be in good standing to be receive series and year end awards.
2. All riders must have a signed waiver prior to schooling or showing. WRC back assigned number must be visible.
3. Proof of negative Coggins test and rabies certificate must be provided with entry.
4. The horse show management reserves the right to limit classes or entries in any class or division. Also to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, as the competition warrants. More rules on club website. Judges decisions are final.
5. Champion be awarded to the rider scoring the highest number of points within the division. Must have three in the division to award a champion. Point for placing: 1st-6 pts, 2nd-5 pts, 3rd-4 pts, 4th- 3 pts, 5th- 2 pts, 6th- 1 point. Or by the highest number of blues in division and downward till tie is broken. Ties are broken by the highest placing equitation class. If tie still stands show committee will toss coin.
6. WRC is practicing Social distancing. Pre-entry is required to minimize points of contact. Adding a class is permitted the day of the show.
7. You must indicate at the start of show if you intend to compete in a division. Pick **One** pleasure division.
8. USEF rules apply. USEF age is as of December 1st. WRC rules govern were applicable.
9. WRC, managers or volunteers and or property owners will not be responsible for any accidents, loss or damages which may occur to any horse, rider, spectator, groom or equipment before, during or after the horse show.
10. Ranch Horse classes use ECRRA patterns and rules but are not part of the ECRRA program.
11. Returned checks will be charged according to ReSubmit program.
12. Dogs must be leashed at all times.
13. Underscored Numbered classes indicate qualifying classes for the main ring division champion. Awarded in the ring: sash and/or other awards
14. WRC Trail Area Divisions awards will distributed at the banquet.
15. Member awards also given at banquet. Note: Separate Payment is required for Club membership (WRC Membership Fee: \$20 Individual, \$30 Family – may join day of show you wish to earn points – subject to final approval at next WRC meeting.) **Must compete in two shows to qualify for year end series and member awards.**
16. Therapeutic classes are open to any seat.
17. Open Beginner horse/pony and beginner rider divisions are day end divisions (not year-end divisions).
18. Office Open by 7 a.m. Check in: Verify that you made it to the show. Drop off your check and pick up your number.
