

Contest Division – Any Seat

Leadline – Walk/Jog May show in beginner division if they meet the criteria (10 & under; no cross entry in Jackpot Classes)

Beginner – Walk/Jog (Any age, first two years of showing; no cross entry in Jackpot classes)

Jr. Youth – 13 & Under

Sr. Youth – 14 to 17

Adult – 18 & Over

Club ages are as of December 1st, 2021 (Club has aligned with USEF age for all show series)

Email Pre-registration by Wednesday 5pm prior to show. Late fee \$25

Division Fee: \$35 includes classes within that division plus Opportunity classes (fun class, mystery class and team race).

Opportunity classes: Offer the chance to fix something, try something new or stretch a rider's ability. Riders will get one point for entering this class. The division fee covers the entry.

Jackpot Class Fee: \$10 entry fee per class. Jackpot barrels and Jackpot dash for cash.

50% Payback amount determined by # of entries; 1st place = 25% 2nd place= 15% 3rd place = 10% of entry fees paid into class.

1. Fees: All divisions entry fee is \$35.00. Jackpot classes are \$10. Exhibition classes are \$5. Grounds Fee \$5. Office Fee \$10. Late fee is \$25 after 5 p.m. Wednesday.

2. All riders must have a signed waiver prior to schooling or showing in addition to wearing their WRC assigned back number. All riders under 18 must wear properly fitting ASTM and SEI headgear with harness secured when riding anywhere on the show grounds.

3. Proof of Negative coggins test and rabies certificate must be provided with entry.

4. The horse show management reserves the right to limit classes or entries in any class or division. The horse show management also reserves the right to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, as the competition warrants. More rules on club website.

5. Champion will be awarded to the rider scoring the highest number of points within the division. Must have three in the division to award a champion. Point for placing: 1st- 6 pts, 2nd- 5 pts, 3rd- 4 pts, 4th- 3 pts, 5th- 2 pts, 6th- 1 point. Or by the highest number of blues in division and downward till tie is broken. If tie still stands show committee will toss coin.

6. Day end awards for each WRC division will be awarded at the Banquet with the series end awards

7. WRC, managers or volunteers and or property owners will not be responsible for any accidents, loss or damages which may occur to any horse, rider, spectator, groom or equipment before, during or after the horse show.

8. Returned checks will be charged according to ReSubmit program.

9. Dogs must be leashed at all times.

10. Sportsmanship is expected at all times. Show staff are volunteers. Please appreciate their work.

33. **Opportunity Team Race** - Open to all ages and abilities – *Different Class each show, will be posted the morning of the show*

Fun Classes

Egg Race – Start run between timing cones, ride down & back around marker while holding an egg on the back of your first and second finger Finish run between the timing cones.

Break & Out – (Walk & Trot) command class must perform command within 30 seconds of request. Ride off may require canter/Lope

Egg & Spoon – (Walk & Trot) command class must perform command within 30 seconds of request. Ride off may require canter/Lope

Magazine Race – receive a # from announcer, ride to the barrel rip only that page out and return through the timers

Obstacle Race – complete pattern in order

Bat Race – riding outside the cones, break timer, ride to person holding the bat- retrieve and finish outside the timing cone

Dollar Bareback – (Walk & Trot) command class must perform command within 30 seconds of request. No wet horse, clothing or equipment

Lollipop Race - Start run between timing cones, ride down & back around lollipop board chose one. Finish run between the timing cones.

Mystery Classes

Speed Ball – Start with ball in hand, riding inside the cones, break timer, ride to an inverted cone ride behind and return to finish inside the timing cones

Speed Barrels – riding inside the cones, break timer, weave three barrels in a row and finish outside the timing cone

Hour Glass – riding inside the cones, break timer, ride outside far cones and finish inside the timing cones

Scurry – riding inside the cones, break timer, complete the course in any order following the requirements and finish inside the timing cones

Thread the Needle – riding inside the cones, break timer, ride between markers, ride behind and around the back marker complete the loop like threading a needle return to the finish inside the timing cones

Opportunity Team Classes

Ribbon Race – riding outside the cones, break timer, ride around far cones and finish outside the timing cone

Relay Race – riding outside the cones, break timer, ride around far cones between cones pass off flag and finish outside the timing cone

Underpants Race – Team of two. Rider #1 starts timers inside the cones, break timer, ride around far cones between cones pass off underpants to Rider #2 they put on underpants over jeans and finish inside the timing cone.
