

Divisions (USEF Age Applies, December 1st, 2022)

- Rules and information:**
 - Fees: All divisions entry fee is \$35.00.
 - The Galen Memorial Stake Challenge class is \$10.
 - Grounds fee \$5
 - Office Fee. \$10
 - Late fee is \$25 after 5pm Wednesday. Individual Class slips are required too. A fillable form is provided on the calendar page of the website.
 - Show fees checks made to Wild & Wooly Horse Show
 - Membership Fees checks made to WRC
2. All riders must have a signed waiver prior to schooling or showing. WRC back assigned number must be visible.
3. Proof of negative Coggins test and rabies certificate must be provided with entry.
4. The horse show management reserves the right to limit classes or entries in any class or division. Also to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, as the competition warrants. More rules on club website. Judges decisions are final.
5. Champion be awarded to the rider scoring the highest number of points within the division. Must have three in the division to award a champion. Points for placing: 1st-6 pts, 2nd-5 pts, 3rd-4 pts, 4th- 3 pts, 5th- 2 pts, 6th- 1 point. Or by the highest number of blues in division and downward till tie is broken. Ties are broken by the highest placing equitation class. If tie still stands show committee will toss coin. Riders and members must be in good standing to be receive series and Year End Awards. Riders must participate in two shows in the series to qualify for division and year-end awards
6. WRC is practicing social distancing. Pre-entry is required to minimize points of contact. Adding a class is permitted the day of the show.
7. You must indicate at the start of show if you intend to compete in a division.
8. USEF rules apply. USEF age is as of December 1st. WRC rule govern were applicable.
9. Wild & Wooly, WRC, managers or volunteers and or property owners will not be responsible for any accidents, loss or damages which may occur to any horse, rider, spectator, groom or equipment before, during or after the horse show.
10. Ranch Horse classes use ECRRA patterns and rules but are not part of the ECRRA program.
11. Returned checks will be charged according to ReSubmit program.
12. Dogs must be leashed at all times.
13. Series end awards given at the banquet. Riders need not be a member to receive these highpoint awards.
15. Member awards also given at banquet. Note: Separate payment is required for Club membership. (WRC Membership Fee: \$20 Individual, \$30 Family, 18 year old members must have Individual membership – may join the morning of the show you wish to earn points – subject to final approval at following WRC meeting. Members must be in good standing to receive any division awards.)
16. Open Masters, Open Adult & Therapeutic & Contest classes are open to any seat.
17. Open Beginner horse/pony division is open to any seat.
18. Sportsmanship is always expected. Show staff are volunteers please appreciate their work.
