

**1. Fee information:**

- o Divisions (USEF Age Applies, December 1st, 2023)
  - o Fees: All divisions entry fee is \$45.00.
  - o The Hunter Hack Jackpot & Galen Memorial Stake Challenge class fees are \$20.
  - o Grounds fee \$5 (Waived for WRC members)
  - o Office Fee. \$10
  - o Late fee is \$20 after 5pm Wednesday prior to the event.
  - o Individual Class slips are required. A fillable form is provided on the calendar page of the website.
  - o Show fees checks made to **Wild & Wooly Horse Show**
  - o WRC Membership Fees checks made to **WRC**
2. All riders must have a signed waiver prior to schooling or showing. WRC back assigned number must be visible.
  3. Proof of negative Coggins test and rabies certificate must be provided with entry.
  4. The horse show management reserves the right to limit classes or entries in any class or division & cancel or combine any unfilled classes, as the competition warrants. More rules on club website. Judges decisions are final.
  5. Division Champions will receive award after the third underlined class in division All classes count in Ranch and Sport Horse.
  6. Pre-entry is required to minimize points of contact. Adding a class is permitted the day of the show.
  7. You must indicate at the start of show if you intend to compete in a division.
  8. USEF rules apply. USEF age is as of December 1st. WRC rule govern were applicable.
  9. Wild & Wooly, WRC, managers or volunteers and or property owners will not be responsible for any accidents, loss or damages which may occur to any horse, rider, spectator, groom or equipment before, during or after the horse show.
  10. Ranch Horse classes use ECRRA patterns and rules but are not part of the ECRRA program.
  11. Returned checks will be charged according to ReSubmit program.
  12. Dogs must be leashed at all times.
  13. Series end awards given at the banquet. Riders need not be a member to receive these highpoint series awards.
  14. Series Champion to be awarded to the rider scoring the highest number of points within the division. Must have three in the division to award a champion. Point for placing: 1<sup>st</sup>-6 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup>-5 pts, 3<sup>rd</sup>-4 pts, 4<sup>th</sup>- 3 pts, 5<sup>th</sup>- 2 pts, 6<sup>th</sup>- 1 point. Or by the highest number of blues in division and downward till tie is broken. Ties are broken by the highest placing equitation class. If tie still stands show committee will toss coin. Riders and members must be in good standing to be receive series and Year End Awards. Riders must participate in two shows in the series to qualify for division and year-end awards
  15. Member awards also given at banquet. Note: Separate payment is required for Club membership. (WRC Membership Fee: \$20 Individual, \$30 Family, anyone 18 year of age must have Individual membership – may join the morning of the show you wish to earn points – subject to final approval at following WRC meeting. Members must be in good standing to receive any division awards.)
