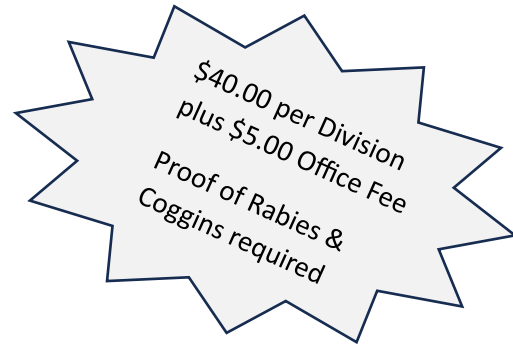

Summer Series Schooling / Contest Show Series Highpoint & Williamsport Riding Club Highpoint Member series divisions
(USEF Age Applies, December 1, 2024)

1. Show registration Fee information
 - a. Fees: All divisions entry fee is \$40.00
 - b. Grounds Fee is \$5.00
 - c. Show Fees cash or check made out to Williamsport Riding Club
 - d. **Entries received after 5 pm on the Wednesday prior to the show and/or the day of entries**
DIVISION FEES ARE \$45.00
 - e. Submit Pre-Entry registration by emailing vmiller.041914@gmail.com
 - f. Pre-entry is greatly appreciated and will help the morning of check in run smoother and faster.
Adding classes and/or division is permitted on the day of the show.
2. All riders must have a signed waiver prior to schooling or showing. WRC back numbers assigned must be visible.
3. Proof of negative coggins test within 12 months and rabies certificate must be provided with entries.
4. The horse show management reserves the right to limit classes or entries in any class or division & cancel or combine any unfilled classes, as the competition warrants. More rules on the club website. Judge's decisions are final.
5. **Participation in two shows are required to qualify for the series and WRC member year end awards.**
6. USEF rules and AQHA rules govern. WRC rules govern where applicable.
7. The Summer Series Schooling / Contest Show Series, WRC, managers, or volunteers and or property owners will not be responsible for any accidents, loss or damages which may occur to any horse, rider, spectator, or equipment before, during or after the horse show.
8. Returned checks will be charged according to Resubmit program.
9. Dogs must be always leashed and mannerly. Please keep back from the rail for safety reasons.
10. Series end awards will be given at the year end banquet. Riders need not to be a member to receive these highpoint series awards. Must participate in two shows to qualify.
11. Series Champion be awarded to the rider scoring the highest number of points within the division. Must have three in the division to award a champion. Point for placing 1st – 6 points, 2nd – 5 points, 3rd – 4 points, 4th – 3 points, 5th – 2 points, 6th – 1 point. Or by the highest numbers of blues in the division and downward till tie is broken. Ties are broken by the highest placing equitation class. If tie still stands show committee will toss a coin. Riders and members must be in good standing to receive series and year end awards. Riders must participate in two shows to qualify for division and year end awards.
12. Member awards also given at the banquet. Note: Separate payment is required for the club membership. (WRC Membership Fee: \$20.00 individual, \$30.00 Family, anyone 18 years of age must have individual membership – may join the morning of the show you wish to earn points – subject to final approval at the following WRC meeting. Members must be in good standing to receive and division awards.)
13. Sportsmanship is always expected. Show Staff are volunteers, please appreciate their work. Please bring any issues of poor sportsmanship or horsemanship to the show management immediately.
