**1. Show registration Fee information:**

- o Fees: All divisions entry fee is \$45.00.
  - o The Hunter Hack & Galen Memorial Challenge class fees are \$10.
  - o Grounds fee \$5 (Waived for WRC members)
  - o Office Fee. \$10
  - o Show fees cash or checks made to **Wild & Wooly Horse Show**
  - o The late fee is \$10 after 5pm Wednesday prior to the event.
  - o Submit registration by emailing [wildandwoolyhorseshow@gmail.com](mailto:wildandwoolyhorseshow@gmail.com)
  - o Pre-entry is required to facilitate the check-in process. Adding a class is permitted on the day of the show. A fillable form is provided on the calendar page of the Club website. Individual Class slips are generated with fillable form. [williamsportridingclub.com](http://williamsportridingclub.com)
2. All riders must have a signed waiver prior to schooling or showing. WRC back assigned number must be visible.
  3. Proof of negative Coggins test within 12 months and rabies certificate must be provided with entry. months
  4. The horse show management reserves the right to limit classes or entries in any class or division & cancel or combine any unfilled classes, as the competition warrants. More rules on club website. Judges decisions are final.
  5. Daily Division Champions will receive award after the third underlined class in division, all classes count in Ranch division. Pick up ringside after each division.
  6. Participation in two shows are required to qualify for series and WRC member year end awards.
  7. Open Means Any Seat may show in the class as well as Therapeutic, Trail area and Contest classes.
  8. USEF rules govern. WRC rules govern were applicable.
  9. Wild & Wooly, WRC, managers, or volunteers or property owners will not be responsible for any accidents, loss or damages which may occur to any horse, rider, spectator, or equipment before, during or after the horse show.
  10. Ranch Horse classes use ECRRA patterns and rules but are not part of the ECRRA program.
  11. Returned checks will be charged according to ReSubmit program.
  12. Dogs must be always leashed and mannerly. Please keep back from the rail for safety reasons.
  13. Series end awards given at the banquet. Riders need not be a member to receive these highpoint series awards. Must participate in at least two shows to qualify.
  14. Series Champion be awarded to the rider scoring the highest number of points within the division. Must have three in the division to award a champion. Point for placing: 1<sup>st</sup>-6 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup>-5 pts, 3<sup>rd</sup>-4 pts, 4<sup>th</sup>- 3 pts, 5<sup>th</sup>- 2 pts, 6<sup>th</sup>- 1 point. Or by the highest number of blues in division and downward till tie is broken. Ties are broken by the highest placing equitation class. If tie still stands show committee will toss coin. Riders and members must be in good standing to receive series and Year End Awards. Riders must participate in two shows in the series to qualify for division and year-end awards
  15. Member awards also given at banquet. Note: Separate payment is required for Club membership. (WRC Membership Fee: \$20 Individual, \$30 Family, anyone 18 years of age must have Individual membership – may join the morning of the show you wish to earn points – subject to final approval at following WRC meeting. Members must be in good standing to receive any division awards.)
  16. Sportsmanship is always expected. Show staff are volunteers, please appreciate their work. Please bring any issues of poor Sportsmanship or Horsemanship to the show management Immediately.
