

Colonial Classic and CJAI Qualifying Divisions (USEF Age Applies, December 1st 2025)

**Note: Colonial Classic and CJAI require a WRC membership to qualify.
A signed complete application with separate payment is required.**

WRC Membership Fee: Checks made to **WRC** (\$30 Individual, \$45 Family)
Club insurance specificities anyone 18 years and older, must have Individual membership.
Memberships may be submitted on the morning of the show to collect points. Memberships are subject to final approval at the following WRC meeting for full club privileges. Members must be in good standing to be recommended to the Colonial Classic, CJAI show and to receive any division awards and member year end awards.

Day End & Series Divisions

1. Fees: Division fee is \$45.00. Any single class is \$20. Office Fee \$10.
Grounds Fee \$5. Waived for WRC members. A late entry fee is \$10 after 5 p.m. Wednesday.
Registrations Due By 5pm Wednesday prior to the event. Email to wildandwoolyhorseshow@gmail.com
Show registration checks made to **Wild & Wooly Horse Show**
Returned checks will be charged according to the Re-Submit program at Woodlands Bank.
2. All riders must have a signed waiver prior to schooling or showing in addition to wearing their WRC assigned back number. All riders must wear properly fitting ASTM and SEI headgear with harness secured when riding anywhere on the show grounds.
3. Proof of negative Coggins test (within 12 months) and rabies certificate must be provided with entry.
4. The horse show management reserves the right to limit classes or entries in any class or division. The horse show management also reserves the right to cancel or combine any unfilled classes as the competition warrants. More rules on WRC club website. The judge's decisions are final. If you wish to speak to the judge, permission must be granted by the show office.
5. Champion will be awarded to the rider scoring the highest number of points within the division. Must have three in the division to award a champion. Points for placing 1st- 6 pts, 2nd- 5 pts, 3rd- 4 pts, 4th- 3 pts, 5th- 2 pts, 6th- 1 point. Ties are broken by the highest placing over fence class or by the highest number of blues in division and downward till tie is broken. If tie still stands show committee will toss coin.
6. Championship awards for each division will be awarded ringside.
7. Series end awards will be available at the year-end awards banquet. **Must compete in two shows to receive year end series and member awards and to qualify for the Colonial Classic and the CJAI Show.**
8. You must indicate at the start of the show if you intend to compete at the two qualifying opportunities CJAI and the Colonial Classic Show. See WRC Membership Form.
9. USEF rules apply. USEF age is as of December 1st. WRC rule govern were applicable.
10. Wild & Wooly, WRC, managers, or volunteers and/or property owners will not be responsible for any accidents, loss or damage which may occur to any horse, rider, spectator or equipment before, during or after the horse show.
11. All classes except Open Warm up 10 & Under Division and Open Hunter Hack Division classes qualify for the Colonial Classic Show. Highest points earned from all three shows are recommended.
12. Dogs must always be leashed and mannerly. Please keep back from the rail.
13. Sportsmanship is expected at all times. Show staff are volunteers. Please appreciate their commitment.
14. WRC Membership is not required to participate in this show series, only if qualifying for Colonial Classic, the CJAI or if earning member year end points. This series does offer series end awards presented at the banquet.
